3. An approved backflow preventer will be required for all industrial or commercial uses, for properties in the rural zone and for swimming pools.
4. Acceptance of the water supply signifies acceptance of the Council's conditions of Water supply bylaw and regulations.
5. Water supply will not be connected by the Council until all relevant fees and charges have been paid.
6. This application is valid for 12 months from the date that the Council accepts the application.
7. If payment has not been received by the end of the financial year (30th June), there will be a change in the charges in accordance with the fees and charges for the new financial year.
